



CHSA Recommended Inspection Report Information

The following is a recommended minimum standard for information that should be on a lifting device as defined in the scope of B167-08

- 1. Date of the inspection*
 - 2. Equipment make, model, capacity and serial number if available of the equipment*
 - 3. Other equipment identification information or numbers*
 - 4. Customer or owner's name*
 - 5. Inspector(s) name*
 - 6. List of safety related defects that could cause the equipment to be unsafe to use*
 - 7. List of recommended maintenance repairs and recommendations*
 - 8. Comments relating to any defect or recommendations found*
 - 9. General overall status of the equipment such as;*
 - a. The equipment inspected was found to be safe to use at the time of inspection*
 - b. The equipment inspected was found to be safe to use at the time of inspection but is in need of maintenance related repairs.*
 - c. The equipment inspected was found to be in need of safety related repairs at the time of inspection.*
 - d. The equipment inspected was found to unsafe to use and should be taken out of service until repairs have been completed.*
